

This is an English language excerpt from the new Ethical Rules of the Liszt Academy, which concern the ethical behaviour of students.

If you experience any unethical behaviour at the Liszt Academy, you may turn to administrative staff for help with familiarizing yourself with all ethical rules enforced at the Liszt Academy, and you may submit a complaint to the 5-member Ethical Committee within 30 days of experiencing the unethical behaviour.

## ETHICAL RULES

(Excerpt)

## RULES CONCERNING STUDENTS

7. §

- (1) Students are bound to:
- a) Cooperate with the University's staff, particularly the professors;
- b) Show loyalty towards the University, and solidarity and respect towards the University's members;
- c) To achieve results through genuine and individual work;
- d) Publish the results of their own research;
- e) Appropriately reference all sources quoted;
- f) Help their fellow students' work and academic progress by their actions;
- g) Refrain from disturbing classes and/or their fellow students' work;
- h) Refrain from making or using unauthorized photos, videos or sound recordings;
- i) Express objective and measured opinion in the reviews of teacher's academic work;
- j) Dress properly for the events of the University.
- (2) Students are obliged to use only authorized study aids in the course of their professional and upstanding work. The student is obliged to refrain from the using of unauthorized study aids.
- (3) It qualifies as using unauthorized study aid if the student:
- a) Uses or tries to use any study aid not permitted by the professor
- b) Attempts to use other persons' contribution in not permitted ways
- c) Assists in points a) or b) as mentioned above
- (4) The visions of article 7 must apply to all students conducting scientific work.
